	Classical Strategical concepts/topics like isolated pawn, hanging pawns, positional sacrifice, weak squares etc. is something every chess player run across in his practice. Therefore developing skills and showing understanding of such positions is based on knowledge about all pros and cons.
	Lesson #1 – Isolated Pawn pros & cons: This is one of the most investigated topics in chess. This is question where many chess players are taking one side – they strongly prefer to play with isolated pawn or versus it. In this topic we will learn typical ways of play with isolated pawn (making central break, creating attack on king, regrouping heavy pieces etc.) & how to play versus it (simplifying position, development of pieces, defensive ideas etc.).
	Lesson #2 – Hanging Pawns pros & cons: In this topic we will learn what are the most important things we need to achieve with hanging pawns (i.e. developing and increasing dynamical potential hanging pawns have) & how to fight in case we are playing vs it (creating pressure on hanging pawns, fixing it etc.).
	Lesson #3 – Weak Squares: Occurence of weak squares in the most of cases means that side which has it is in problems. However, many openings are based on giving this positional advantage to opponent in order to get something (initiative, development etc.) for it. Therefore here we will meet key facts which we need to take in order to acess those type of positions.
	Lesson #4 – Positional Sacrifice pros & cons: Positional sacrifice in any position implies material imbalance. However, it does not mean that every positional sacrifice is good and that it will bring effects which are expected. Therefore, developing instinct and understanding of position which arrives after sacrifice is key of making good positional sacrifice & avoiding wrong positional sacrifice.
