## Camp Info

## Capacity 12

**Theme** One of the most important things for player who wants to improve his level is to know what he should do in practicular position. Understanding of particular position in middlegame is based on knowledge about typical pawn structures and how exactly one should play it. In this camp one will learn how to play or deal with universal formations which are established in early stage of game.

Lesson #1 - Formation with double c pawns I (dxc6 or dxc3): Current formation might come from various openings/lines (Sicilian Defense/Rossolimo Setup, Ruy Lopez/Exchange Var/Berlin Wall, Scotch Opening, Italian Game etc.) and usually leads to positions where one side decides to give bishop pair in order to create double pawns;

Lesson #2 - Formation with double c pawns II (bxc6 or bxc3): Compared to Formation I, here positions have more dynamical character. Usual openings/lines where we can meet it are Nimzo-Indian Defense, Rossolimo Variation in Sicilian Defense, English Opening etc.

**Lesson #3 – Double Fianchetto Formation:** Type of positions with double fianchetto (which has one side or even both sides) are connected with English Opening/Setups even it is possible to see it in Sicilian Defense, Pirc Defense, Modern Defense &Gruenfeld Defense). Main character of this formation is that action in center comes in later stage of game compared to other setups.

Lesson #4 - Hedgehog Formation: This is one of the most universal setups which has main character that White has space advantage, while Black has more flexible position. It might come from various openings – Sicilian Defense/various lines, English Opening, Queens Indian Defense etc.

Lesson #5 - Maroczy Formation: Together with Hedgehog this is formation which might come from various openings. Compared to Hedgehog, Black is not controling square d5. Beside Maroczy Variation in Sicilian Defense, this formation might come in other variation of Sicilian Defense(i.e. 1. e4 c5 2. Nf3 d6 3. d4 cxd4 4. Qxd4!? etc.)
